Please join Nuu-chah-nulth First Nations and our supporters on Tuesday, February 12th at 8:30 am with drums in hand and raised voices to show your support and solidarity *“for one of the largest aboriginal fisheries cases to hit Canadian courtrooms” (Vancouver Sun)*. We will be gathering on the steps of the Vancouver Law Courts, at the corner of Nelson and Hornby Streets in downtown Vancouver, at 8:30 AM.

Stand with Nuu-chah-nulth leaders to show your commitment to the recognition of our histories, rights, and reconciliation with Canada for access to our sea resources.

Through the Nuu-chah-nulth Fisheries Litigation, our Nations are continuing their efforts to have their rights and title to sea resources, recognized, respected and implemented.

This case commenced trial in April 2006 and is scheduled to continue until fall 2008.
